Many homes in the Conservation Area really need to enjoy the benefits of double or triple glazed windows, but strict interpretation of planning rules make this very hard to do.

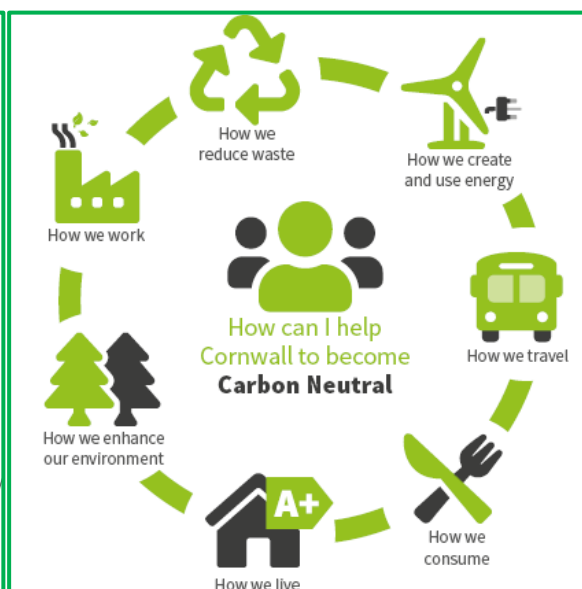
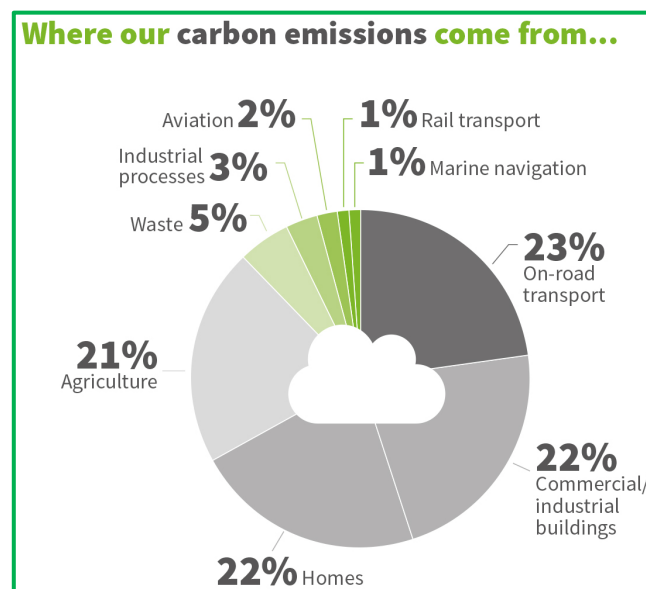
